Congratulations on the recent publication of your article in *Global Health: Science and Practice*! Ensuring that your article gets the attention it deserves is just as important as publishing it. Use these strategies below to promote your article and ensure it reaches the widest audience.

Social Media	Share your article on social media and tag @GHSPjournal.
Online Communities	Listservs, communities of practice, institutional newsletters: Post a short summary to relevant listservs, newsletters, with a link to the article.
	Personal/institutional websites: Post a link to your article in your online bio/CV or in your institution's list of resources.
	R Academic communities: Post a link to your article on your academic community profile (e.g., Mendeley, or Research Gate).
Blog	Write a blog post to recap your findings more informally. Ask to post it on your institutional blog site or, if in the FP/reproductive health field, on the Knowledge SUCCESS blog (email request to
Altmetric	 editorialoffice@ghspjournal.org). Altmetric tracks and reports attention to your work from thousands of online sources, including mainstream news outlets, policy documents, and social media. Click on the Altmetric donut on your
	article page to see who's talking about your research, where they are, and what they're saying.
